“Phil Schacht” Junior-Scholarship

Purpose and Amount of the Scholarship

Phil Schacht has been a long member and mentor of the club before his tragic passing. Phil has put his soul and life in promoting aviation to young children of all ages. ESA wants to continue that spirit in line with our mission, and with this scholarship awards a junior member that has shown continuous and has exceptional involvement with ESA through the junior flight program. The Phil Schacht Junior Scholarship shall recognize a junior who demonstrates passion and motivation to take flying serious but also fun.

The scholarship is awarded no more than four times per calendar year.

The recipient receives a \$200 credit to be used with ESA. Funds may be used to pay for flight time in one or more of ESA’s divisions. No monetary funds are paid out directly to the recipient and use of flight or membership credit is tracked through our bookkeeping process on MyFBO. The scholarship credit must be used within 2 years before any unused funds become void. Scholarships are non-transferable.

Publicity of Program

The Phil Schacht Junior-Scholarship is advertised and promoted through the ESA newsletter as well as at least at one general meeting.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, a candidate must be a current junior member of ESA. Members of ESA are not eligible for scholarships while serving as an officer. Members may receive more than one scholarship during their membership but a maximum of two per calendar year.

Activities that would be taken into consideration for selection would include: coordinating events, attending fund raisers, assisting with projects, maintenance and service duties, and other personal involvement.

Application and Selection Process

Any current ESA junior member may apply for this scholarship.

The application shall:

- Include a brief personal description
- Include a summary of participation and flying at ESA
- List a description of goals and ambitions with ESA
- Include a plan on how to pursue the above mentioned goals
- Include one letter of recommendation attached to the application

Recommendations shall be sent by email or mail to the current ESA president and secretary. Recommendations must be received by midnight of the deadline date to be considered.

Selection Criteria

The selection is based on the involvement the junior candidate has with ESA. Besides the participation level, other factors such as time as a member, fund raisers, volunteer duties, and other activities are considered.

The selection committee reserves the right to change the dollar amount and number of scholarships granted each year. The committee reserves the right not to issue the scholarship if the recommended candidates do not appear worthy of the award.
